## Lauren's Supply List (March 2023):

Please feel free to bring anything not on the list.

### Paint:

- Half-pan or tube set such as Winsor & Newton, Holbein, Daniel Smith. Buy the best paints your budget will allow.
- Basic Colors:
  - Blue: Ultramarine Blue and Phthalo Blue
  - Red: Cadmium Red and Permanent Rose (or Alizarin Crimson or Quinacridone Magenta)
  - Yellow: Cadmium Yellow and Lemon Yellow
  - Brown: Burnt Umber

**Note:** We'll talk more about colors during the first class

You may also use a butcher tray, coated paper plates, other smooth surface with raised sides

### Brushes:

- You'll only need a few to get started: A dagger (about size 8), a larger round wash with a point (1/4"-1/2"), a rigger (about size 1-4) If you already have brushes, bring them.
- I like the Royal and Langnickel Zen line 83.

### Surface:

5" x 7", 9" x 12" or 8" x 10" cold press (not) watercolor paper 140 lb in a block, pad or loose sheets. 100% cotton paper will make a BIG difference, but it is pricey (\$2 +- per sheet) if you can but choose whatever fits your budget. Canson Montval is a good quality student grade paper.
